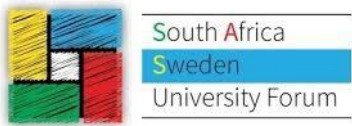
Congratulations!

The abstract that you submitted was subjected to a rigorous double-blind peer review by knowledgeable experts in the subject and ACCEPTED for submission of a full paper on or before **15 April 2019 at 23:50**.

The full paper submission is expected to comply with the following requirements:

1. The Title of the Paper should not exceed 50 words.
2. The paper should be written in British English.
3. The whole paper should not exceed 5000 words.
4. The paper should be typed in Ms Word in a 12pt font size Times New Roman with a 1,5 line spacing.
5. All papers should be accompanied by an Abstract of not more than 250 words. The abstract should have addressed all the remedies pointed out by the anonymous Reviewers.
6. Only a Harvard style of referencing will be accepted for the purposes of the Symposium and its publications.
7. Authors should ensure that all the technical and language aspects of their paper submissions are of high standard.
8. The name(s), contact details and affiliation of author(s) should appear on a separate or cover page.
9. By submission of the paper the author confirms that co-authors have consented to its submission, presentation in the Symposium and possible publication as part of Symposium Proceedings.
